Albert "A.C." Charles Vincent was born on January 30, 1938 in Youngsville and he was a longtime resident of Milton. A.C. was a true Cajun through and through: he was tough on the outside but was a soft-hearted man whose presence could light up any room with laughter or song. He was a proud veteran of the US Navy and even had the opportunity to be on the world's first guided missile destroyer, the US GYATT. A.C. also worked for Louisiana DOTD for many years before retiring from there.

A.C. was known as Papa. He was always working to provide for his family. He enjoyed fishing, farming, gardening, roosters, and even racehorses. He found

joy in the simple things: singing old songs, drinking a cold beer, and throwing out one of his many sayings, like answering with “Is the Pope Catholic?” instead of saying “Yes.” A.C. was strong-willed character; a man who made his mark with his humor, dedication, and the unmistakable warmth beneath his tough exterior. He loved going to church, loved his people deeply, and left behind stories and smiles that will be remembered and cherished for generations to come.
