An interment will be held at the Black Hills National cemetery in Sturgis, South Dakota, with full military honors on June 18th at 2:30 pm for Andrew Wendelin Keller, age 80, who passed away on Saturday, June 7, 2025 at the Calcutta House in Lafayette.

Andrew was born on February 18, 1945 in McLaughlin, South Dakota, and he was a longtime resident of Lafayette. Andrew grew up as a cowboy on the family ranch in McLaughlin and was the South Dakota bull riding junior state champion in 1961 and 1962. After graduating high school, Andy enlisted in the navy from 1963-1967. Upon being honorably discharged, he began a career as a helicopter mechanic in Lafayette, LA. He later went on to work in the oil field industry and traveled the world extensively. Andy took pleasure in cooking and entertaining. He enjoyed the outdoors and was an avid fisherman and hunter. During retirement he spent his time creating art work, that he would gift to his friends and family. He will be deeply missed by his family and loved ones.
