He owned and operated Touchets Bar for over 27 years, and he was also employed as a School Bus Driver for the Vermilion Parish School Board. Calvin's life was rooted in his service to his community, as well as his strong faith. He served on the Jury Selection Committee for Vermilion Parish for many years, and he was also a Past President of the North Vermilion Booster Club. He was a member of the Cajun Culture Association, and he was a recipient of the "Living Legend"

award for his contribution to Cajun Culture and Cajun Heritage. No matter where he went, Calvin was always the life of the party. He enjoyed a good time, and he lived his life to the fullest. In his spare time he enjoyed traveling with his wife Donna, and camping with friends. Calvin was also known for cooking, he dearly loved cooking for his family and his many friends. More than anything Calvin will be remembered as a loving husband, father and grandfather. He will be dearly by his family and his friends.

Calvin is survived by his loving wife of 46 years, Donna Broussard Touchet of Maurice; his sons, Dwayne Touchet of Abbeville, and Derek Touchet (Kristy) of Maurice; his grandchildren, Tyler Touchet, Adalynn Touchet, and Harper Touchet; his great grandchild, Atom Touchet; his sisters, Janelle Pennington of Arizona, and Gloria T. 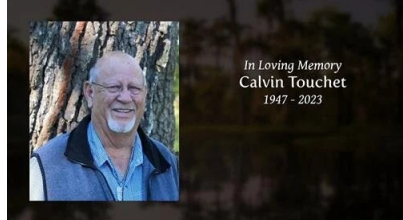
