His favorite vegetable was a Hershey bar with almonds and his biggest pride and source of joy was his children and grandchildren. David knew that every day was a gift.

David is survived by his children, Kimberly Yoder and her husband, Joshua, Angela Hubbell, Christian Hubbell, and Melissa Barton; his sister, Kitty Credeur and her husband, Timmy; his mother, Geraldine Hubbell; his ten grandchildren who loved their "Gum Gum" very much.

He was preceded in death by his father, Dr. Gerald Hubbell.
