



## Dennie Ray Kinsey

A Funeral Service will be held on Saturday, February 24, 2024, at 2:00 pm until 3:00 pm in Our Savior's Church in Broussard for Dennie Ray Kinsey, age 70, passed away peacefully on Friday, February 9, 2024, at The Carpenter House in Lafayette.

Dennie was born on October 8, 1953, in Lake Charles to Weldon Emmanuel Kinsey and Hazel McMills Kinsey. He was never alone, sharing a womb with his twin sister, Donna. There has been great debate about who came first. Dennie tore up the streets of Morgan City until his family moved to New Iberia at the age of 14, when he met his neighbor and future love of his life, Bonnie Delcambre. Dennie was a drummer in the NISH marching band and graduated with the class of 1971. He continued his education at the University of Southwestern Louisiana (UL) where he learned some amazing co-ed trampoline skills that he loved to show off to his children and their friends. On May 11, 1973, after 5 years of dating, Dennie and Bonnie married. Dennie worked for his father-in-law with Delcambre's Pest Control for 10 years before going into business for himself in 1982. Dennie was a people person and loved nothing more than his regular visits with his customers who throughout the years had become friends and extended family. In 1981, Dennie and Bonnie had their first child, Jesse and in 1988 came their second child,

Chelsea. Dennie loved many things: guns, fishing, music, riding 4 wheelers, camping, sitting out by the fire, crawfish boils, the beach and watching the beautiful colors God painted in the sunsets. But most of all, Dennie loved his family. Dennie poured his entire life into his wife and children making sure that they were taken care of until the very end. He was larger than life and his huge personality and smile will be greatly missed, along with his fudge and first place ribs. He leaves behind a legacy of unconditional love, compassion, and selflessness. Heaven is rejoicing today and so is he.
