



Felix Enrique Torres

June 5, 1942 - February 18, 2024

A Graveside Service will be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, at 2:00 pm at Bellevue Memorial Park in Opelousas to honor the life of Felix Enrique Torres, age 81, who passed away on Sunday, February 18, 2024, at The Carpenter House in Lafayette, after a short illness.

Felix Enrique Torres Ledesma was born in 1942 in Orocovic, Puerto Rico. He grew up alongside one brother, first in the mountain town of Jayuya and later in San Juan. He graduated from high school, studied bookkeeping, and enlisted to serve in the United States Army. He traveled to the US to undergo basic training at Fort Jackson in South Carolina and then logistics training at Fort Gordon in Georgia before being stationed at Fort Polk in Leesville, Louisiana. While in Louisiana, he married and settled in Opelousas, where he remained for the rest of his life. He had three children and worked as a painter. Felix lived life to the fullest. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and dancing. He was generous and would give anyone the shirt off of his back. Felix never met a stranger and had many friends from all walks of life. He will be dearly missed.

Felix is survived by his daughters, Angela Torres Spallino (Bryan) and Vanessa Torres Hulin (Kevin); his son, Brennan “Ricky” Enrique Torres (Andrea); his step-son, Cecil Depre; his five grandchildren; his two step-grandchildren; his niece; his three nephews; as well as his dear friend;
