Gerald "Jerry" L. Landry Jr. was born in Lafayette on February 12, 1964. Gerald is survived by his mother Verna Landry, his wife of 36 years Johnette Ladner Landry, his daughter Jency Landry, mother in law Laura Lee Viator and numerous Aunts, Uncles, Cousins, and friends whom he loved and adored very much. He also leaves behind his cherished companion grand pup Otis.

He was preceded in death by his father Gerald L. Landry Sr., paternal grandparents Dieu Donne and Philomene Landry, maternal grandparents Otis and Helen Broussard, and father-in-law John J Ladner.

After 25 years of service, Gerald retired from the Lafayette Fire Department in 2007. He then went on to work for American Claims Service Inc. as a claims adjuster for 12 years. Having grown up hunting and fishing his whole life with his father, grandfather, and friends, he was a natural outdoorsman and was a hunting guide for Doug's Hunting Lodge in Gueydan for many years.

Jerry never met a stranger, was beloved by many, and always ready for a good time. His favorite moments included spending time with his family, going to the beach, listening to music, watching the LSU Tigers, and eating at La Fonda's with his family. He was the most devoted son, cherished husband, supportive and doting father, and loyal friend.

We are eternally grateful to the remarkable people who rushed to the scene to be by his side, including the first responders who worked tirelessly to help save him. Jerry lived his life always ready and willing to help people in need. It has brought our hearts some peace knowing that he was surrounded by compassionate, outstanding, loving people during his last moments.

“ My name is Crystal Guillory and I was a witness to Mr Gerald's accident. He missed hitting my vehicle by about 3 inches going at such a high speed. Jesus was in that parking lot that day. Although he called Mr Gerald home he missed hitting every pedestrian and every vehicle in a very busy area. We all stayed with him that witnessed the accident until the paramedics took him away. We prayed for him that Jesus would put breath back into his body. It was a very beautiful moment. Black people , white , people , old and young big and small. We all joined together and prayed for Mr Gerald. All though we did not know him we cared about him. Thank you so much for recognizing us in his obituary. It has warmed my heart tremendously. I have been struggling dealing with what I saw that day and that simple acknowledgment did my soul so much good to know that yall knew that he was not alone when he took his last breath. Thank you for that . And I am so sorry for his mother , his wife , and his daughter for having to lose him in this way. I don't know if yall had an autopsy done on him or not but it is very important to me that his family and friends know that he did not die from the crash. It was obvious to all of us that he was having a medical emergency that caused his crash. My prayers are with you all and please pray for me as well that I can move past this traumatic event that I witnessed. God bless.

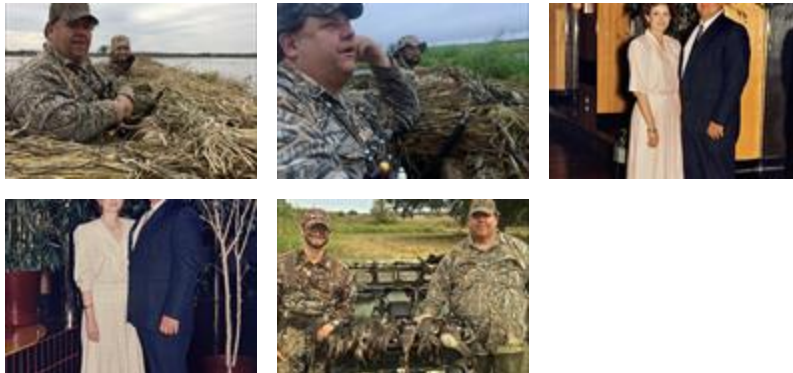
