Private Internment Services will be held at Lafayette Memorial Park Cemetery in Lafayette, Louisiana.

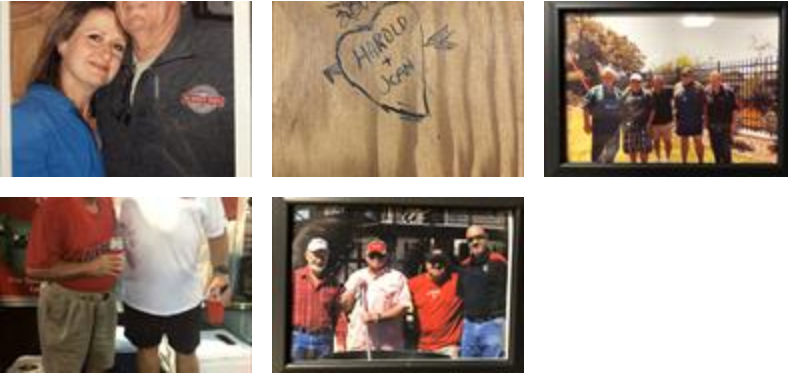

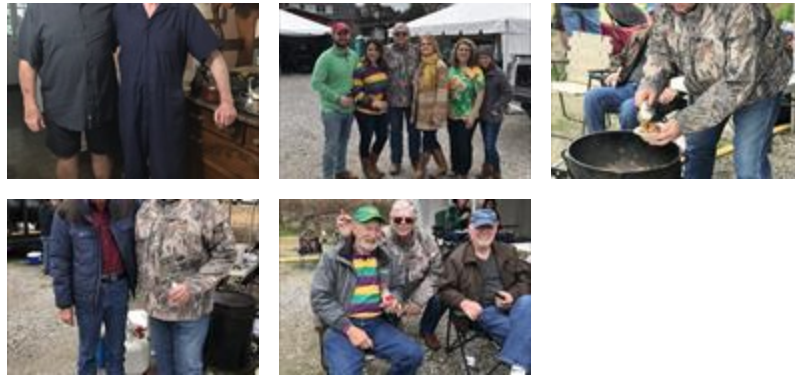

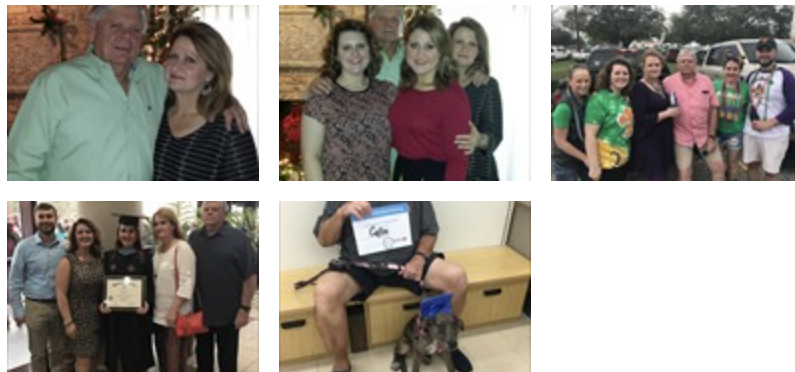
