Judy P. McBride was born on November 1, 1942, in Birmingham, Alabama. Judy attended the University of Alabama and proudly cheered “roll tide”. Judy moved to Louisiana and married Pat. Pat’s career relocated them from Louisiana to California and finally moving back to Broussard in 2016. She worked as an office manager, administrator, and campaign manager. Judy never missed an excuse to buy a new pair of work shoes or a classy outfit; some nieces referred to her as “aunt shoesie”. As a court appointed advocate for CASA and an officer of PEO, Judy had a passion for helping others and finding ways to better the lives of those around her.
