Mary was born on June 22, 1937 in Lafayette, Louisiana to Randolph and Ella B. Trappey. She was the youngest of four children. Mary was the valedictorian of her Mt. Carmel Class of 1955. She went on to graduate from Southwestern Louisiana University in 1959, eventually returning to her studies to earn her Masters + 30. She was a librarian for 26 years with the Lafayette Parish School System, having worked at Youngsville Middle, L. Leo Judice, Ossun Elementary and retiring from Woodvale Elementary, where she started the Book Character Parade, something she was always proud of. After retirement, she continued to work in the school system as a substitute teacher and teaching assistant. She proudly served a term as the President of the Lafayette Library Association.

During her summer breaks from school, she would travel to Hermosa Beach, CA to her son, Stephen's Ragin Cajun Restaurant where she taught cooking classes, introducing the Californians to the delights of Cajun Cuisine. She enjoyed crocheting, specially making baby blankets for MeMaw's grandchildren and great grandchildren. She also loved spending time at the beach, playing bridge, reading, and trying her luck at the casino. Her most treasured moments were those spent with her husband, children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren.
