



## Ralph "Mickey" Huffman

Ralph "Mickey" Huffman, 92, of Maurice, Louisiana, passed away peacefully on Thursday, May 15, 2025.

Born in Itasca, Texas, to Obe Dare and Agnes Huffman – Mickey was the youngest of nine children—including two sets of twins—and was himself a twin. From an early age, Mickey stood out as a remarkable athlete. At Itasca High School, he excelled in football, baseball, basketball, and track, setting the stage for a lifelong love of sports and mentorship.

After high school, Mickey attended Hardin-Simmons University and was later drafted by the Philadelphia Athletics to play professional baseball. In 1953, he joined the U.S. Coast Guard, stationed in Cape May, New Jersey. During his service, an opportunity arose when the base admiral asked who wanted to transfer to Hawaii. Mickey's hand "nearly broke the sound barrier" going up—an enthusiastic yes that would change his life forever.

It was in Hawaii that he met Miss Aloha Hawaii 1954, Maureen Stevens, and the two were married on October 30, 1955. He went on to graduate from the University of Hawaii, where he also played football.

Mickey loved the game—whether it was golf, baseball, or watching football on Sundays—but nothing brought him more joy than his family. With the arrival of his four children (Steve, Michael, Margaret, and Randy), his focus turned fully to coaching and teaching. Guiding young minds, both on and off the field, became his life's passion.

For 69 beautiful years, Mickey was married to the love of his life, Maureen Stevens Huffman, until her passing in January 2025. Their love and partnership stood as an example to all who knew them.

Those who knew Mickey—“Coach” to many—remember him for his unwavering dedication, generous heart, and deep love for his students and players. His legacy lives on in the lives he touched and the lessons he instilled.
