Randall Stuart Farquhar, 76, of Dry Creek, passed away May 12, 2023 at The Carpenter House in Lafayette after a brief illness.

Mr. Farquhar was born in DeRidder at Beauregard Memorial Hospital on July 27, 1946, the younger son of the late Herman Farquhar and Christine Green Farquhar. He graduated from East Beauregard High School and attended Louisiana State University before enlisting in the U.S. Air Force. Prior to his retirement, Mr. Farquhar was employed by Fujitsu; upon retiring, he owned and operated a small machine repair shop. He was a member of Grace Church. His favorite hobby was tending his farm "critters." Before Mr. Farquhar became disabled, he was an avid fisherman, and enjoyed participating in church activities and visiting with his family, friends, and

neighbors.
